Construction of a new Student Reception and Enquiry Centre situated within the Frenchay Campus.

This building, *as shown right*, was constructed on a site completely surrounded by existing buildings using a high tech steel frame. It features an attractive curved glass curtain walling frontage and internally an extensive glazed screening gives a light and airy feel to the open plan facility.



To add to the feeling of space, sun tubes and lantern lights have been included within the roof membrane. In addition, a circular aperture in the first floor, allows natural light to cascade through both floors.

Access between floors is via a purpose made helical staircase of stainless steel and powder coated metal construction. Disabled access is via a glazed platform lift.

Extensive Health & Safety measures had to be implemented in order to isolate and segregate the site from university staff, students, visitors and members of the public. Regular liaison meetings, held with key stakeholders from the university, enabled us to co-ordinate and programme activities to ensure disruption was kept to an absolute minimum.

When completed this building became the main architectural feature on the university's Frenchay Campus.
