The purpose of this Contract was to ensure that Bristol's Lord Mayor's Mansion House met the requirements of the Disability Discrimination Act (DDA).

Our Contract Team worked collaboratively with the Client throughout the design, pre-contract and construction phases. This ensured that the contract proposals were deliverable and that all work activities undertaken did not affect this landmark building's unique characteristics.

Experienced contract personnel created a new entrance underneath the existing conservatory from the garden and constructed a lift shaft. The end result meant that the passenger lift (giving access to all floors) was installed harmoniously into the building, looking as if it was always intended. Also, to ensure that the new timberwork lining the lift doors matched the existing surrounding timber, contract personnel used traditional staining and graining techniques.



Extensive Health & Safety measures were implemented as all work activities were undertaken while the building was in full operational use with functions and events being held throughout the whole of the contract period.
