Montreal Protocol

ERH Communications is a key provider of high quality communications infrastructure, technology together with maintenance and civil engineering services. These services are carried out whilst maintaining a close and responsible interest in the environmental impact of its undertakings.

ERH Communications is aware of the requirements of the Montreal Protocol and is committed to the protection of the Ozone Layer.

All gases used in air conditioning at premises owned by ERH are a blend of hydro fluorocarbon or HFC compounds, which have no chlorine content and no ozone depleting potential.

ERH Communications fleet transport does not include any vehicles manufactured prior to 1994 and therefore does not use air conditioning systems with ozone depleting R-12 refrigerant.

All aerosol products used and purchased by ERH Communications contain liquefied gas; usually a butane propane mix.

ERH Communications does not possess fire extinguishers containing Halon gas nor are any chemical substances retained or used which contain carbon tetrachloride and or methyl chloroform.

The organisation acknowledges that its activities have an impact on the environment and is committed to minimising any harmful effects. Protection of the environment and sustainability are at the heart of our Environmental Management System which meets the requirements of ISO 14001:2004.
